## CRIMES AGAINST PERSON • CRIMES AGAINST PERSON

**Including:** Murder, Manslaughter, Homicide (UCR 09A); Negligent Homicide (UCR 09B); Justifiable Homicide (UCR 09C); Kidnapping, False Imprisonment, Sexual Battery (UCR 100, 11C, 11D); Rape (UCR 11A, 11B); Aggravated Assault and Battery (UCR 13A); Obstruction of Justice, Simple Assault and Battery (UCR 13B); Obstruction of Justice, Stalking, Intimidating (UCR 13C); Incest, Carnal Knowledge (UCR 36A, 36B); Misdemeanors (UCR 90Z)

### ALL CRIMES AGAINST PERSON:

The following data must be entered for all Crimes Against Person.

### VICTIM TAB

**ASSAULT CIRCUMSTANCES** Must make at least one selection -- no duplicates are allowed. **Unknown** can only be selected when no other selection is made (mutually exclusive with other codes).

**Note:** When **Other Felony Involved** is selected, then incident must contain at least two (2) felony offenses.

### SUSPECT TAB

**VICTIM-SUSPECT RELATIONSHIP** For every Suspect, this indicates any relationship with a victim or victims. The gender of the victims and suspects must reflect their implied relationship.

This relationship can be omitted only when there is nothing known about the suspect or suspects; or, the **Type of Victim** is **Society** or **Public**.

**Valid choices** when the victim and suspect are **within the same family**, and the victim was:

Spouse	Ex-Common Law Spouse, Etc.)
Common Law Spouse	Stepchild
Parent	Stepparent
Sibling (Brother or Sister)	Step-Sibling (Stepbrother or Stepsister)
Other Family Member (Step-Grandparents,	Non-Married Live-In

**Valid choices** when the suspect was **not a family member** but known to the victim, and the victim was one of the following:

Babysittee (the Baby)	Ex-Spouse
Boyfriend or Girlfriend	Friend

**Valid Choices** when the suspect was not known by the victim: Relationship Unknown or Stranger

**Other Valid Choices:** Victim was Offender

- Criminal Attacked by Civilian

- Unable to Determine or Not Enough Information

When **Type of Victim** is **Law Enforcement**, one of the following activities must be selected:

- Responding to Disturbance Calls (Family Quarrels, Man with Gun, Etc.)
- Burglaries in Progress or Pursuing Burglary Suspect
- Robberies in Progress or Pursuing Robbery Suspect
- Attempting Other Arrests
